Fred Meijer White Pine Trail State Park
Sand Lake to Stanwood

The 20.5-mile section of trail from Sand Lake to Stanwood is now paved, except about a mile of trail north of M-46 where a culvert will be replaced with a bridge sometime this summer. Expect a possible detour. Ride through shady woodlands, peaceful farm country and the rural villages of Pierson, Howard City, Morley and Stanwood. Now is a great time to explore this new section of trail.

The trail through Howard City was also repaved last summer, and includes a connector path to local businesses west of the staging area. The Howard City Staging Area offers plenty of parking and is close to several stores, restaurants and ice cream shops. In Morley, you'll cross a bridge spanning the Little Muskegon River. Look east to see the Morley Dam and Morley Pond. You'll also find restaurants and ice cream in this quaint village.
