

biking or paddlesport adventures with ample lodging, camping and amenities located on or near most of the trails. This includes an extensive network of rail-trails built on the remnants of several major railways that once brought travelers to Northern Michigan's vacation wonderland and hauled freight to be ferried across the Straits of Mackinaw.

The Top of Michigan Trails Council was responsible for gathering public support and working with the Michigan DNR to develop these trails over the past two decades. Their visitors center is located at the intersection of the Little Traverse Wheelway and the North Western State Trail near Petoskey.
